All transportation and meals will be in place to get participants to Kelowna, through accreditation, and checked into accommodation sites on Wednesday, July 22.

SHOWERS: Showers are located at Parkinson Recreation Centre. A scheduled time is noted in this Bus & Meal Schedule each day where you will be bused to this facility and provided a window of time in which to shower. Please bring your shower gear with you each day. Please be mindful of your length of showers, as there is limited shower capacity available. Please be respectful of other patrons at this facility. Coaches should work together to ensure their zone teams are not all going into the showers at once.

Before leaving the accommodation site for breakfast, bring your luggage to the front entrance and load into the luggage truck assigned to your sport. You **MUST** load all luggage **EXCEPT FOR** competition and shower gear. You will not be returning to the accommodation site. If a luggage truck is not present, leave luggage at the main entrance of the accommodation site. In that situation, volunteers will pick up your luggage later in the morning. The luggage truck will take your luggage to the Departures Area and volunteers will place it in a designated area for your sport. You will be dropped off at this location after your competition.

Upon arrival at the Departures Area at Okanagan College, collect your luggage from the designated storage area for your sport. Then take your luggage drop it at the designated space for your method of travel home. If you are on a Games charter bus or flight, drop your luggage at the stall designated with your Bus # or Flight # as identified on your Games travel itinerary. If you are making your own way home from the Games, wait until your parent/guardian is on-site to pick you up before collecting your luggage from the Departures Area.

Once you have dropped your luggage in the designated area, you are welcome to walk to the Closing Celebration at Kelowna Secondary grass fields for an opportunity to celebrate and say goodbye to your fellow participants. The Closing Celebration is an ongoing event that will feature 15 minutes of speeches at 1:15 pm. Not all sports will be on-site for the speeches. Please ensure you depart the Closing Celebration for the Departures Area with enough time to catch your bus or flight departure, even if it means missing the speeches.

All Games travel home departs from the Departures Area between 12:40 pm and 4:15 pm. Board the appropriate bus as identified either by the Bus # or Flight # that is noted on your Games travel itinerary. If you are on a bus home, your Games travel itinerary will show the scheduled departure time from the Departures Area. If you are on flight, you will be bused directly to the airport from the Departures Area after being checked into your flight by BC Games personnel.
