

LEGACY FUND APPLICATION

We are thrilled to launch the Greater Vernon 2022 BC Winter Games Legacy Fund. This initiative goes beyond the world of sport to encompass the broader spectrum of community.

In 2023 Greater Vernon hosted over 1000 participants involved in 15 sports. The Games would not have been possible without the more than 1500 volunteers who stepped up to generously donate their time, skills, and passion for youth sport and their community. This multi-sport event, funded by the Province of BC and supported by many local sponsors, celebrates our province's young athletes and provides development opportunities for coaches & officials.

We are excited to announce that through our Legacy Fund we will be able to support local projects with a cumulative total of approximately \$200,000. This will undoubtedly leave a long lasting impact in our community and truly reflect the spirit of the Games.

Purpose of the Legacy Fund:

The Legacy Fund is committed to investing in initiatives that contribute to the development and sustainability of sports, as well as building systems to assist athletes, coaches, and officials to meet their potential.

Additionally, a portion of the fund can be used to support other non-sport, community-focused projects, such as local arts, education, and cultural programs. The Legacy Fund seeks to create a lasting impact that enriches the entire community.

Eligibility Criteria:

To ensure a fair and comprehensive selection process, the Greater Vernon 2022 BC Winter Games Legacy Fund has established the following eligibility criteria (in alignment with the funding guidelines of the BC Games Society) for potential applicants:

The Project must fit within at least 1 of the following streams:

1. viaSport Designated Sport:

Accredited, recognized, and affiliated sport organizations make sport better through their competence, professionalism, and compliance with viaSport standards. See list of Provincial Sport Organizations that represent the sports list below.

At least 75% of the total Legacy Fund, must be for sports in the following list:

2. Other Community-Focused Projects:

Up to 25% of the total Legacy Fund may support other sport or non-sport related projects that make a short or long-term positive impact in the community.

The Project must be completed within a year if possible and take place within the Greater Vernon Area of School District 22.

Post application deadline:

Questions from committee members to applicants – Sunday, March 17, 2024.

Answers from applicants back to committee members – Wednesday, March 20, 2024.

Final decisions on Legacy Fund allocations – Thursday, April 4, 2024.

Legacy Fund Award Night - Thursday April 18th, 2024. 6pm-9pm
